thicket with a safety route; use a picnic rug and place a tunnel on top



creek; use a hose



bridge; use a door mat

## Set up

You will need: this map, a hose, six objects labelled 1-6 (controls), two mats, a star, a triangle, a picnic rug and a tunnel

Place 'controls' 1-6 as shown on the map. Put a picnic rug on the ground to represent the thicket. Place a tunnel on top of the rug. Anyone moving through the thicket has to crawl through the tunnel. Place a hose to represent the creek, and make two crossing points with door mats. Place a star for orientating the map (or use a compass and draw an arrow on the map to represent the magnetic North).

## Rules of the game

The child stands at the triangle and orientates the map by pointing the star on the map towards the star in the backyard. The child goes to all controls from 1 to 6. Alternatively, the child rolls the dice and goes to the control corresponding to the number of dots on the dice. Is it better to go through the tunnel in the thicket or around the thicket?
